Sharon Jones was elected to her first term as Douglas County Treasurer in November 2002, and her second term in November 2006. Sharon began her employment as a bookkeeper in the Douglas County Treasurer's office in 1977 and within four years was appointed Deputy Treasurer. In 1997, Sharon was promoted to a newly created title of Chief Deputy Treasurer.
